May '20 – Present VECOZO	<p><b>COACH &amp; TEAMBUILDER</b></p> <p>After I build teams and demonstrated that the Scrum Master role has added value for the development teams in the Software Development department, I was asked to coach the management and do some teambuilding for the IT management department. This is necessary because three teams do not yet form a unit and I have demonstrated that I can do this due to what I accomplished at the Software Development department. I do this online because of the Corona virus, four hours a week.</p>
Nov '18 – May '20 VECOZO	<p><b>SCRUM MASTER</b></p> <p>Vecozo is the national communication point for healthcare in The Netherlands. They offer a safe and high-quality digital environment in which chain parties can exchange administrative data. It has 9 Scrum teams. My initial assignment was to demonstrate that the Scrum Master role has added value for development teams. I succeeded (by coaching four teams) and as a result Vecozo has hired two Scrum Masters as permanent employees. With them I organized the first PI planning in order to make priorities at the highest level more transparent and to get a grip on their completion. In addition, I am proud that I have helped teams during a more difficult time, in an open and honest way, to solve these problems with my human knowledge.</p>
Nov '17 – Nov '18 NATIONALE NEDERLANDEN PENSION NEW BUSINESS	<p><b>AGILE COACH</b></p> <p>During our trip in Canada I was approached to coach development teams of the Change and IT department of Nationale Nederlanden to become better at Scrum and the Agile way of working. I managed to significantly improve a number of teams in terms of better Scrum, Dev Ops, satisfaction and performance. I achieved these results by facilitating team building sessions, Agile workshops in combination with coaching on the job.</p>

During this periode:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- I increased the level of testing platform wide by designing and implemented a Risk Based Testing strategy. PRA light for each User story based on acceptance criteria. I connected testers platform wide by organizing test meetings. I took responsibility for the expansion of the platform wide regression test &amp; built and executed automated tests using the automated test tool TOSCA and I prepared and executed functional SAP tests and financial chain tests within an agile team.</li> </ul>

Besides the common known Agile skills, I coached them to become more charismatic and persuasive in their communication.</li> <li>- I trained several groups to become better at Agile techniques like Story Mapping.</li> <li>- I co-developed a maturity wall for 13 teams so that the level of Scrum in each team became transparent so teams could to learn from other teams.</li> <li>- I created funcentives that teams could gain whenever they delivered an user story successfully. <p>April '12 – Oct '12 NATIONALE NEDERLANDEN</p>	<p><b>SCRUMMASTER / TESTCOORDINATOR</b> The project NNCP (Nationale Nederlanden Comfort Pensioen) consisted among others of two Scrum Teams. A new SAP landscape has been newly build and integrated with other systems (Stream Serve for example). My assignment was to improve the test process and the overall scrum quality. During a period of 6 months I succeeded in both assignments by participating in the teams and by coaching the team members and Product Owners.</p>
<p>June '11 – Oct '12 ROBECO</p>	<p><b>SCRUM MASTER</b> I graduated as a certified Scrum Master (PSM I) in June 2011 and as from that time I worked as one of the first Scrum Masters within Robeco. I took the opportunity to put Scrum on the map of the Robeco organisation. Besides acting as a Scrum Master for the project New Global Sites, I did coach a business project. As from March 2012 we trained the Product Owners and Scrum team members of Robeco in an internal training.</p>

Rob was responsible for the testing (functional and performance) of the successful implementation of the website “Mijn Robeco”. The challenge in this project was on one hand the coordination of the Robeco engineers and the engineers of the (in Romania situated) company ISDC, and on the other hand the designing company Clockwork. In the Netherlands Rob was in the lead of a test team consisting of five business analysts. As from summer 2011 he was responsible for the test process of the Tridion Upgrade. The new version of the Tridion application has been taken into production successfully in Februari 2012. SDL Tridion 2011 is the content management system in which Robeco manages all its websites.</p>
